- submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- 5. assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities(such as production of display boards, webpage and to share with other College students their experience abroad);
- 6. Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund according to the following rate:

Region 1: Asia and Oceania – HK\$8,000 (1 course) or HK\$10,000 (2 courses)


Region 2: Europe and Americas - HK\$10,000 (1 course) or HK\$15,000 (2 courses)

- 2. Applicant's participation in the extra curricular activities organised by the College;
- Priority will be given to those who have no previous overseas exchange experience.
