To be eligible for consideration of the Scholarships, students are required to:

1. attend at least 1 credit bearing course offered by the above Universities # ;
2. submit an official transcript issued by the attended University as a proof of completing the course(s);
3. obtain approval from faculties / departments to transfer the credits of the course(s) taken back to CUHK*;
4. submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
5. assist the College in promoting cultural exchange activities (such as producing display boards, webpage and sharing their experiences abroad with other College students);
6. Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund according to the following rate:
 - Region 1 : Asia and Oceania – HK\$8,000 (1 course) or HK\$10,000 (2 courses)**
 - Region 2 : Europe and Americas – HK\$12,000 (1 course) or HK\$18,000 (2 courses)**

Selection criteria are as follows:

1. Applicant's Overall GPA;
2. Applicant's participation in the extracurricular activities organised by the College;
3. Priority will be given to applicants who have no previous experience with overseas exchange programmes.



Application and Deadline:

1. Please apply on-line [here](#) . The deadline for application is 14 January 2025 (14:00). Late applications will not be considered;
2. Once being selected by the College, students need to submit their applications directly to the respective Universities for the courses they wish to attend and provide relevant proof to the College^;
3. Students are advised to visit the webpages of the respective universities for detailed information on admission requirements, available programmes/ courses, accommodation arrangement and fees, etc;

3. submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
4. assist the College in promoting cultural exchange activities (such as producing display boards, webpages and sharing experiences abroad with other College students);
5. Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships of **HK\$12,000 or HK\$18,000** supported by the College Endowment Fund.
