

2024-25 GEUC 1000 "College Assemblies"

Attendance Requirement

- "College Assemblies" (GEUC 1000) is part of the College General Education Programme. It is non-credit bearing but students are required to fulfill a minimum attendance requirement.
- Students are required to attend <u>at least 3</u> College Assemblies or related activities <u>in each</u> school term, i.e. 3 times in Term 1, another 3 times in Term 2.
- 3. Students who cannot fulfill the attendance requirement of College Assembly are permitted to attend a one-time makeup session at the end of each school term, given that they can provide an approved justification for their absence.

Each student is eligible for ONE makeup attendance only, i.e. if a student attend one College Assembly and a one-time makeup session, his/her overall attendance will be counted as 2, and yet still NOT fulfilling the minimum requirement of 3.

- Engineering students in one-year-work-study, and Medicine students and Nursing students in clinical studies are NOT required to attend College Assemblies.
- Students are encouraged to fill in an E-evaluation questionnaire at the end of each College Assembly.
- 6. Students will receive a course grade for GEUC 1000 in each school term based on their attendance records and shown in their transcripts:

[Pass] for those who fulfill "attendance requirement"

[Fail] for "not fulfilling attendance requirement"

The [Pass/Fail] grades of GEUC 1000 will be shown in student's transcript.
